THOUGHTS

Twenty-Third Sunday

Jesus returns from a tour of predominantly gentile districts north of Israel (Tyre and Sidon are cities in what is now Lebanon). Mark introduces this by way of showing that gentile converts were welcome in the community of believers.

Twenty-Fourth Sunday

Mark's Gospel is sometimes called the Gospel of The Secret - the secret of Jesus' true identity. The evil spirits are ordered to be silent. People who are healed of their illnesses are told to keep quiet about it and now the disciples are told to keep to

themselves the truth blurted out by Peter. This is the turning point in the Gospel, now the 'blind', the blind disciples have had their inner eyes opened, now Jesus' mission is revealed to be truly dangerous.
